REGULAR MEETING

June 11, 2024

CALL TO ORDER

The June 11, 2024 regular meeting of the Corydon Township Supervisors was called to order at 6:00 pm by Dennis Faucher, Chairman. The Pledge of Allegiance Followed.

PRESENT

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Michael Yohe made the motion to adopt the May 6, 2024 minutes. Raymond Douglass seconded, all were in favor.

NEW BUSINESS

- Stickney Trail Road Work – Dallas Morris/Bradford Forest Products – All agreed to the proposal to “Mill and Fill” the whole road. Work to be completed by July 31, 2024.
- Road Bonds – Updated Excess Maintenance Agreements – Discussion ensued. All agreed to the updates.

OLD BUSINESS

- Spring Clean Up – A thank you to Bradford Township for their contribution of a packer. It made the clean-up process seamless. There were some complaints regarding the price increase, and “less service.” It was discussed that the Township trucks are not registered to be refuse vehicles. Also, next year’s clean-up will be one day only.
- Verizon and Starlink – A 4-port hub is needed for the connection of the router and telephone for the MagicJack install. Once completed and in working order the Verizon account will be cancelled - looking toward August.
- Quinn Road – Myra Lane – Supervisors agreed that the Myra Lane Sign be erected at the beginning of Daniel Peterson’s driveway.
